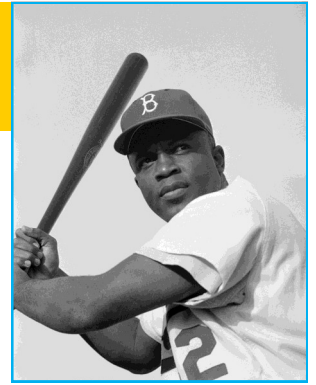

Jackie Robinson, a famous Kentucky Christian

Famous Kentucky Christians are people from the past who gave public credit for their achievements to God. We consider them "from" Kentucky if they lived or worked in this state at some point in their lives. Jackie Robinson was born in Georgia and grew up in California. He was raised by a single mother, joined a gang, and suffered discrimination. Then he chose to believe the Christian message. His life changed. He served in the U.S. Army during World War Two. He coached Army athletics at Camp Breckinridge, Kentucky. It was while he was living in Kentucky that the Dodgers recruited him. He was the first African American to break the color barrier in major league baseball.



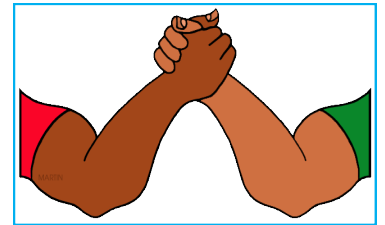
